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Important Update: Potential Delay to SNAP Benefits Due to Government Shutdown

Ashtabula County Job & Family Services knows that many of our SNAP recipients are worried about how the federal government shutdown could affect their benefits. We want to keep you informed.

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) has let us know that **new SNAP benefits may be delayed starting Saturday, November 1st**. We understand this is frustrating, and we currently do not have a timeline for how long this delay might last.

Please Note:

Our team is still here for you. We will continue to process all new SNAP applications and renewals so that benefits can be issued without further delay the moment federal funding is restored.
